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CONTEST RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. The entry fee to participate in the Cookin' on Kampeska Kids' Que is \$10.00 per contestant.
- 2. The contest is open to children ages 6-12.
- 3. A parent or guardian must always be present. Only one supervising adult will be allowed in the cooking area.
- 4. Each contestant will be assigned a cooking area with a table, small tabletop charcoal grill, charcoal, and lighting tools. We request that you keep all your equipment within this area.
- 5. Each contestant will receive 4 hotdogs and a numbered turn-in container. You must bring all other desired seasonings, condiments, garnishes, buns (if you choose to use them), and cooking utensils. (Please bring hot pads or oven gloves as the lids to the grills may be hot.)
- 6. Check-in and set-up will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Friday, July 19th. All contestants should be checked in and at their site by 6:15 p.m. for a brief mandatory cooks meeting and safety session. Grills will be lit promptly at 6:30 p.m.
- 7. Contestants must do all preparations, seasoning, and cooking of their entry. The supervising adult may only assist in the lighting of the grill, assistance with hot grills, and using a knife to cut any garnishes. Adult participation outside of these boundaries will be cause for disqualification.
- 8. The official turn in time will be 7:15 p.m. with a window of 10 minutes (5 minutes before time and 5 minutes after time). No late entries will be accepted.
- 9. Each contestant must turn in 3 whole hotdogs or I hotdog cut in 3 pieces in the provided numbered container.
- 10. The judging for this event will be blind to ensure the integrity of the event. Entries will be judged on appearance, taste, and creativity. All decisions and interpretations by the judges are final.
- 11. Awards will be presented to the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion during the cook-off awards ceremony at 4:30 p.m. on Saturday July 18th.
- 12. Each contestant is responsible for the clean-up of their assigned cooking area. Trash and hot ash disposal containers will be available.
- 13. Adults NO alcohol in the preparation and cooking areas.
- 14. Failure to follow any of these rules will result in disqualification of the contestant.
